



PERSONAL DATA INFORMATION CLAUSE

- 1.** The company TITUTO Sp. z o.o., Zimowit 42 Street, 35-605 Rzeszow, entered in the National Court register under the number KRS 0000416819 by the District Court in Rzeszow, XII Economic Division, TIN: 813-367-20-85 and REGON: 180833938, e-mail address: contact@tituto.com, informs that it is the administrator of all personal data, which will be given by a person in contact with the administrator, in particular personal data such as first and last name, position, function, correspondence address, e-mail address, telephone number, bank account number, PESEL number / TIN number.
- 2.** The purpose of personal data processing is to exchange of information in connection with the conducted contracts by the administrator, including the performance of the contract to which the person is a part, the data refer to, or to take an action at the request of the person, before conclusion of the contract.
- 3.** The personal data are processed by the administrator on the basis of express or implied consent of the person or for the purpose of performance of the contract to which the data subject is a part or to take an action at the request of the data subject prior to the conclusion of the contract.
- 4.** The administrator may share personal data with his employees and associates and entities that participate in the process of conclusion or performance of contracts concluded by the administrator. The disclosure of personal data to third parties is made with compliance of applicable laws.
- 5.** The administrator does not transfer personal data to a third country or to international organizations.
- 6.** Personal data will be stored no longer than it is necessary, i.e., for a period of time when the contract is performed and for the period determined by the applicable rights provisions.
- 7.** The person whose personal data is processed by the administrator is entitled to request from the administrator of an access to his personal data, rectification, deletion or processing restrictions, the right to object to personal data processing, the right to transfer personal data, the right to bring a complaint to the supervision authority and an obligation that giving a personal data is a contractual requirement and condition of concluding a contract.
- 8.** Based on the provided personal data, the administrator will not take automated decisions, including decisions resulting from profiling. Profiling means any form of automated processing of personal data consisting of the use of personal data to evaluate certain personal aspects relating to a natural person, in particular to analyze or predict aspects concerning that natural person's performance at work, economic situation, health, personal preferences, interests, reliability, behavior, location or movement.
